
Rovanco Piping Systems

A Rovanco pre-engineered piping system is built around a pipe that has a need to be insulated or contained. That pipe can be any one of many materials, including PVC, steel, copper or stainless steel. The basic insulating material is urethane foam. When required mineral wool, calcium silicate, fiberglass and foamglass are used to handle critical high temp applications. A wide range of protective

jacketing materials are available including PVC, polyethylene, steel and aluminum.

Lochinvar Training in Fargo

Last month we brought in a Lochinvar Factory Service Tech to provide training on the Knight and PowerFin boilers in Fargo. Various contractors from around the area attended including: Manning, Robert Gibb, Peterson, HA Thompson, Lunseth & Mowbray & Sons.

Topics of discussion included installation, operation, controls, maintenance and troubleshooting. These

contractors are now factory trained to provide installations, startups, service and preventative maintenance on Lochinvar Knight and Powerfin boilers and water heaters.

In combination with this Lochinvar training and the Fulton training last year, most of the North Dakota contractors are now factory trained on all of our products. We will continue to provide new factory training in the future.
